

Esko High School PSEO Off-Campus Participation Acknowledgment

Esko High School offers students the opportunity to earn college credit through our Post-Secondary Enrollment Options (PSEO) programming. While most students participate in our on-site college courses taught at Esko High School which offer the same courses and college credits, students may also choose to enroll in **PSEO courses offered off campus or online through a college or university**.

Because off-campus PSEO participation differs significantly from courses offered at Esko High School, students and parents/guardians must review and acknowledge the following considerations before enrolling.

Important Considerations for PSEO Off-Campus Participation

- **Courses are taken off campus or online** through a college or university and are **not taught by Esko High School staff**.
- **Students must register independently** with the post-secondary institution and **declare intent to enroll in PSEO by May 30** in accordance with Minnesota law.
- **Parents/guardians will not receive grade or performance updates** from the college due to federal student privacy laws.
- **Esko High School staff cannot provide registration, academic support** for courses taken off campus. **It is the responsibility of the student to ensure graduation requirements are met.**
- **Scheduling conflicts may occur** with required Esko High School classes, school events, school breaks, or extracurricular activities.
- **Credit loss is possible** if courses are dropped, failed, or not properly aligned with Esko High School graduation requirements. This could impact a student's **high school transcript, graduation timeline, and future college admission**.

Because of these limitations, **PSEO Off-Campus participation is not recommended for most students**. Students and families are encouraged to carefully consider the expectations and responsibilities associated with this option.
